DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES (DENR) SAFETY RULES

The following safety rules are intended to help reduce the chance of accidents and injuries. All employees are expected to comply accordingly.

- 1. Refrain from the use of tobacco products in or on DENR owned, leased or occupied premises, in accordance with DENR's tobacco-free workplace policy.
- 2. Horseplay and fighting will not be tolerated in the workplace.
- 3. Before beginning work, notify your supervisor of any permanent or temporary impairment that may reduce your ability to perform in a safe manner.
- 4. Operate equipment only if you are trained and authorized.
- 5. Inspect the workstation for potential hazards and ensure that the equipment or vehicle is in safe operating condition before using it.
- 6. Immediately report any recognized potentially unsafe condition or act to your supervisor.
- 7. If there is any doubt about the safe work method to be used, consult your supervisor before beginning work.
- 8. Immediately report any accidents, incidents or property damage to a supervisor regardless of severity.
- 9. Immediately report any smoke, fire, or unusual odors to your supervisor.
- 10. Use proper lifting techniques. For objects exceeding 50 pounds in weight, the immediate supervisor shall determine specific methods for safe lifting.
- 11. Never attempt to catch a falling object.
- 12. Fasten restraint belts before starting any motor vehicle.
- 13. Obey all driver safety instructions as outlined in the Department's vehicle operation and monitoring policy.
- 14. Comply with all traffic signs, signals, markers, and persons designated to direct traffic.
- 15. Adhere to Department procedures regarding first aid, evacuation routes, and fire notification.
- 16. Observe all safety notices and posters (i.e., wet floor signs, restricted access area, etc.).
- 17. Keep your work area clean and orderly, to include:
 - a. Ensure aisles/walkways are free of boxes, wastebaskets, chairs and other obstacles that could impede traffic;
 - b. Close desk and file drawers in order to avoid hazards while walking;
 - c. Keep the floor clear of litter.
- 18. Avoid the storage or placement of objects overhead, except where adequate storage is provided.
- 19. Wipe up any liquids spilled on the floor immediately.
- 20. Ensure cords are positioned where they do not pose a tripping hazard.
- 21. Avoid plugging one extension cord into another extension cord and/or using multiple surge protectors.
- 22. Refrain from the use of small electrical equipment in your work area (i.e., fans, space heaters, coffee makers, miniature refrigerators, etc.).
- 23. Assist and cooperate with all safety investigations and inspections and assist in implementing safety procedures as requested.
