- Well #1 – 91,947 barrels of normal butane
- Well #2 – 754,951 barrels of normal butane
- transfer of normal butane from well #2 to well #1 started at 11:30 am on

Current Objectives

- Well #1 – take normal butane from well #2 when not sending to customer
- Well #2 – send normal butane off site to customer

Industrial Water Well Usage

- Water Well #7 (state reg# 007-89) – 15,883 – PDK logging began on 9/28/12
- Water Well #8 (state reg#007-90) – 0 bbls – PDK logging of well completed on 9/27/12

Steps to protect the environment and public safety

- continuously monitoring the well pressures
 - monitored by the plc (programmable logic control) in the control room
- mechanical integrity program for all piping
- hourly visual checks at each well
- the facility is manned 24 hours a day seven days a week
- performing subsidence and horizontal surveys every seven to ten days on the two caverns
