

TRACT 42426 - East Carroll Parish, Louisiana

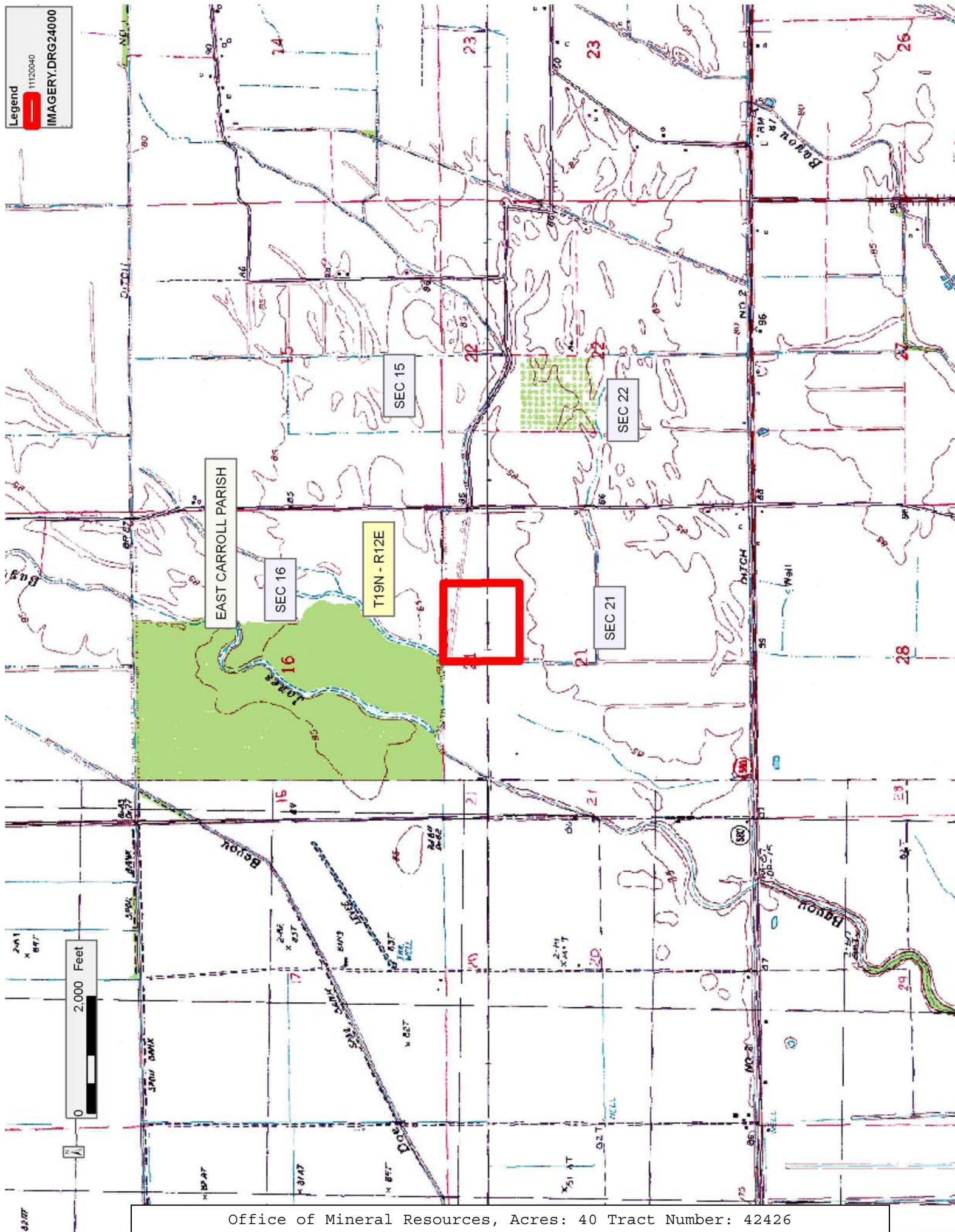
